

Important Information for 2021 STEM Expo weekend

Hello STEM EXPO Students and Parents/Guardians!!

We are **SUPER** excited about the upcoming STEM Expo taking place virtually via Zoom on **Friday, May 14th - 5:00 to 8:00 pm** and **Saturday, May 15th - 8:00 am to 12:00 pm**.

At the time of registration, each student registered for a one hour time slot on Friday evening or Saturday morning, during your designated time slot you will present your project in a breakout room to a panel of four judges. The attached schedule provides your individual project number and date/time you will present your project. Please read below for instructions and reminders to ensure the event runs smoothly for all!

Students please have the **LATEST version of Zoom app installed** to access the breakout rooms and features. **Please be sure to download the latest version this week BEFORE the STEM Expo!**

Students, you must **login using your LUSD Google Zoom account** to ensure you are automatically placed into your preassigned breakout room (set up using your LUSD Google email). If you log in using a parent account, no account or a personal account it will take extra time to assign you to a breakout room. If for some reason you are not automatically assigned you can self-select the appropriate room that pops up on your Zoom screen, your breakout room will be your project number and full name. For example, "3 Landon Hass". If needed, Mr. Coski and I will be available for tech support!

Each student will be in a **breakout room** with teammates (if you have any) and you have 15 minutes to present your project to the judges. Students may do this with or without screen sharing by either presenting orally with a project in their camera view, or by showing a digital presentation. Either way **please** make sure you are prepared to present!

Students please log in **ON TIME** or even a few minutes early as we are running on a very tight schedule. Each student will be in their breakout room for one hour. The judges will either appear during the first or second half hour, so students do not worry if you are sitting in your breakout room for the first 30 minutes waiting for the four judges to appear. At the conclusion of presenting to the panel of judges, students will be asked to "**LEAVE the meeting**". Students do not need to return to the main meeting room.

If at any time you are having trouble or need help during the hour you can return to the main meeting room and Mr. Coski and/or I can provide support.
